## ***Painting of Senior Parking Spaces- 2020***

The Senior Parking Space Lottery will be held on Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am in the High School cafeteria. Seniors will be painting their parking spaces on Monday, July 20<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>. Procedure for obtaining an assigned parking space are as follows.

- The cost per parking space is \$80, which covers the cost for the permit. Payment must be made by Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Please make checks payable to Sunnyvale High School.
- Sketch of your design must be submitted to the office by Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that SHS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.
- The order in which students pick their spaces will be determined using a lottery system. All students who have their designs approved and have paid by Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. will have their names randomly drawn to determine the order in selecting their spot. **The physical lottery drawings will take place on Monday morning, July 6<sup>th</sup>, at 10:00 am in the high school cafeteria.**
- Students are not required to be present for the lottery. Students not present will have a space assigned to them by the Future Readiness Advisor or campus Principal.
- Students who are approved for painting a parking space must select an outlined space on the parking lot diagram during the lottery.
- Completed Senior Parking Application must be on file in the office. Forms are available at the front office and at [www.sunnyvaleisd.com](http://www.sunnyvaleisd.com).

In order to follow all city and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking spaces.

- **WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX** paint is the only type of paint that can be used.
- No Reflective paint
- No Spray paint
- No Fluorescent paint
- Students must keep a 4" unpainted border between the white parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. (please use blue painters tape)
- You may purchase WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint at retail stores like Sherwin Williams, Lowes, or Home Depot.

All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office for approval by the administration. Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. On your design sheet, please include your first and last name, email address, and cell phone number where you can be reached. Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email letting you know if it is acceptable or if any changes need to be made.

All designs are due no later than **Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. in the SHS front office.** There will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors on any changes that need to be made. Checks should be made payable to Sunnyvale High School. If you have any questions, please contact the front office at 972-203-4600.

- **Time Line For design approval and lottery:**

Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. Window opens for design request submissions

Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Window closes for design request submissions

\*After student's design is approved, they will be notified that they are being entered in the lottery,

Wednesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. School officials draw lottery names and students select spots

- **Timeline for Parking Lot Painting**

Tuesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> Students are able to clean their spots. No cleaning will take place after the 19<sup>th</sup>.

Monday, July 20<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> Painting approved spaces

**Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup> All Painting has to be completed by the 25<sup>th</sup>**

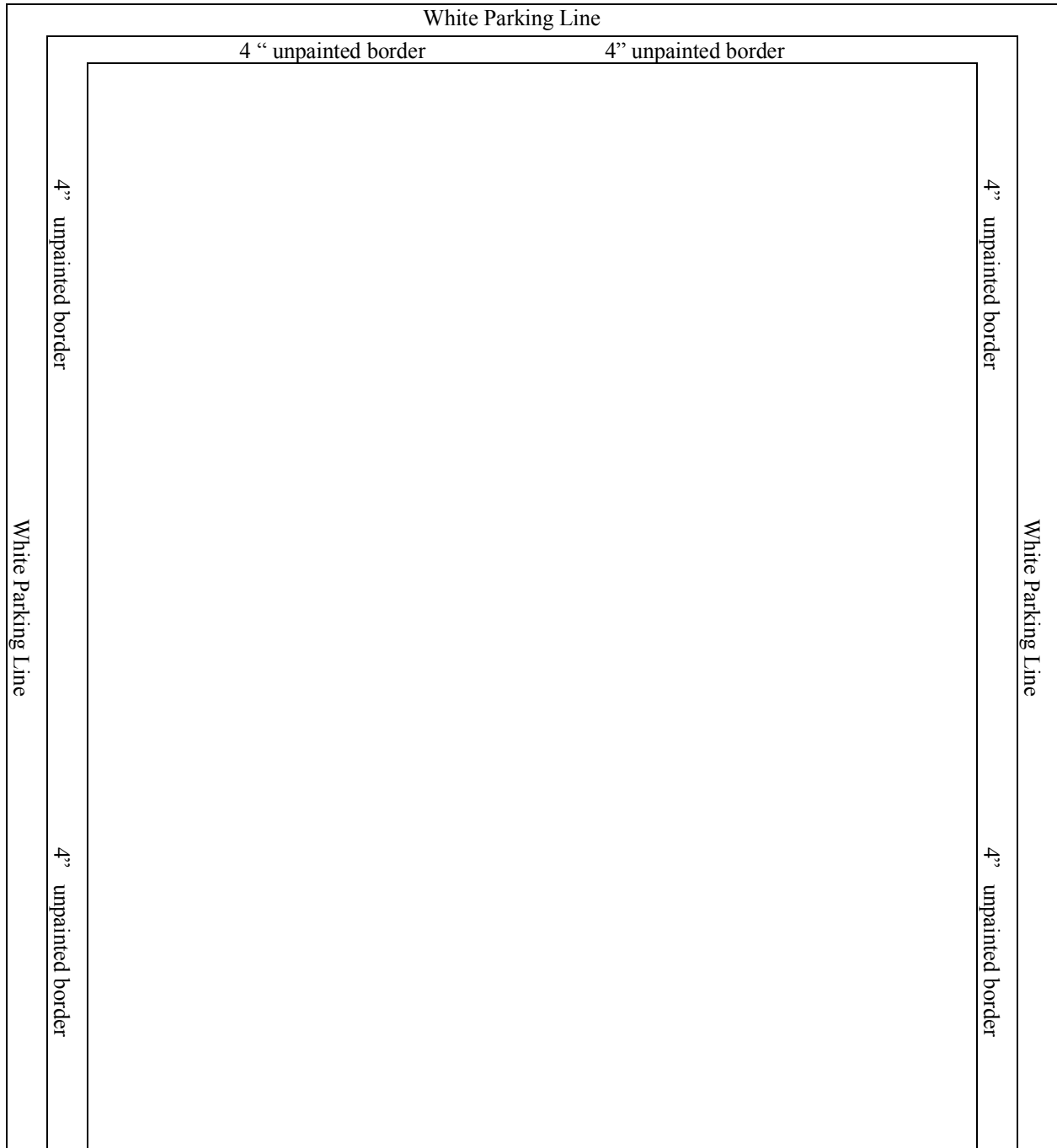
In order for paint to dry completely, parking in designated spaces will not be allowed until Monday, **July 27<sup>th</sup>.**
