

Sunnyvale Intermediate School: 3rd - 5th Grade

All Academic Subjects

- A minimum of 1 numeric grade in each subject per week will be recorded and averaged per grading period.
- Grades are weighted equally in all subjects except ELAR.
 - ELAR will be broken down as follows:
 - 40% Reading, 20% Word Work, and 40% Writing
 - Minimum Number of Grades: Reading - 6; Writing - 5 (consisting of no less than one composition), Word Work - 5
- Grades must be updated weekly on the online grade book.
- All students will have the opportunity to correct a class assignment for a maximum grade of 70.
- Students may have the opportunity to retake/correct tests for a maximum grade of 70, at the discretion of the teacher.

Special Academic Subjects

- Special Academic Subjects (such as Art, Music, and PE) indicators include E, S, N, and U to evaluate student progress.
 - E = Excellent – consistently exceeds expectations
 - S = Satisfactory – consistently meets expectations
 - N = Needs more time developmentally to achieve expectations
 - U = Unsatisfactory – fails to meet expectations
